It is equipped with the sophisticated Advance<sup>TM</sup> microprocessor control configured with the IntelliSet<sup>TM</sup> option, which makes it easy to select optimum refrigeration profiles from a simple scrolling list of commodities.

“We’ve also included Carrier’s ReeferManager<sup>TM</sup> programming software, download cables and PC cards, giving owner/operators an extra measure of autonomy for configuring the reefer and adjusting operating profiles as they desire to help optimize fuel reduction,” Porto said.

Designed with sound quality in mind, the X2 Special Edition has acoustic foam on the interior surfaces of the doors and features the new V-Force condenser fan that eliminates noise-generating pulsations. The Stealth 2 package includes a tuned intake system that further suppresses noise.
